## What's Happening

We're introducing Community Safety Zones at Kingston area schools to improve road safety, support active travel to school, and establish more consistent expectations for driver behaviour.

The planned Community Safety Zones for École Catholique Cathédrale and Sydenham Public School are shown below.

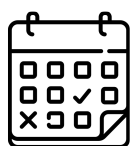


## Community Safety Zones



Community Safety Zones remind motorists that they are driving in an area with higher volumes of pedestrians and vulnerable road users, such as near schools. The fines for many traffic violations, including for speeding, are doubled within Community Safety Zones to improve compliance with the posted speed limit and to encourage motorists to drive with increased caution and care.

## Project Timeline



Since last summer, Community Safety Zones have been established at more than 30 schools in Kingston. For the remaining schools, installation of the required signage for the Community Safety Zones is underway and will be completed by the end of 2023.
